() red

H/S "ROLLOS" in red for pianola rolls. Also seen with "DISCOS COLABORACION" (in red) and "E.R.A." (in violet).



010 c.1910. Type **1**, imperf. circular. For "Grands Disques" (presumably 12"). () red **H/S** Ozam







010 c.1910. Type **2**, imperf. For "Phonographe". () red **H/S** Ozam

H/S Charlesky (French music-hall singer, yodeler and composer)

The last four possibly by Pathé for particular artists, as they were with an accumulation where the others were all early Pathé stamps.
